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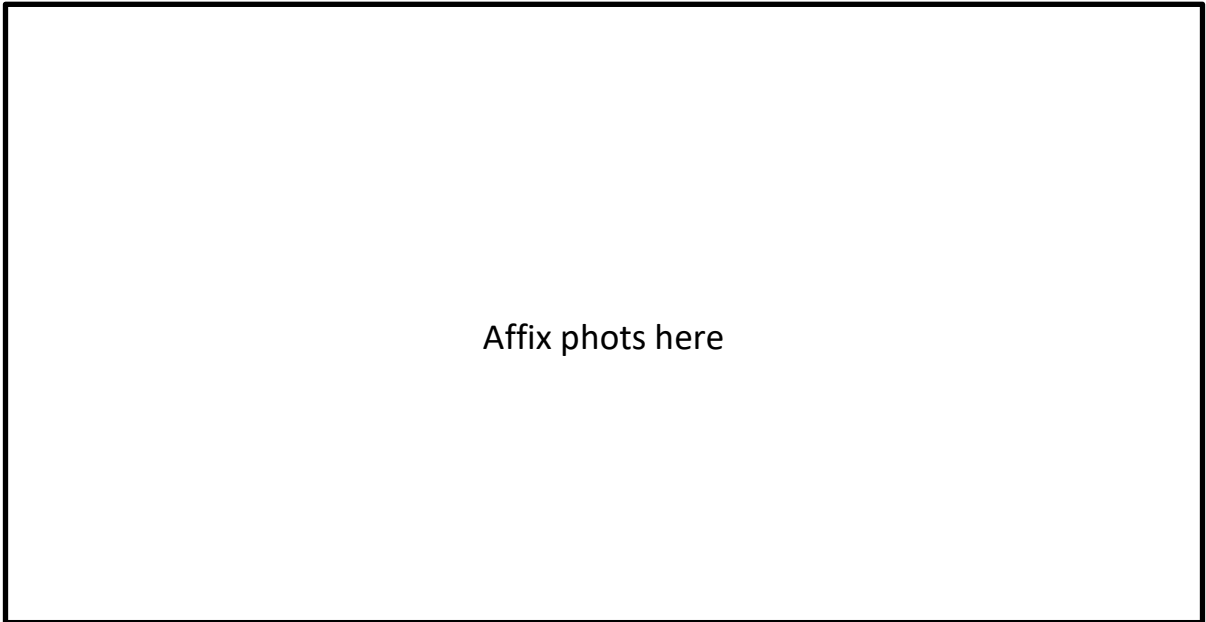

Equine Hair (Mane) Collection Procedure

When collecting equine hair for DNA testing, it is important to note that it is the hair follicles (roots) that contain the DNA required for analysis, rather than the hair shaft itself.

It is important to note:

- You should only ever collect samples from *one horse at a time*.
- It is best to handle the hairs *as little as possible*.
- A foal's mane hair is very fine and can break easily. If you are taking a hair sample from a foal, *it may be better to take hair from the centre of the top of the tail* to ensure that you obtain hair follicles (roots)

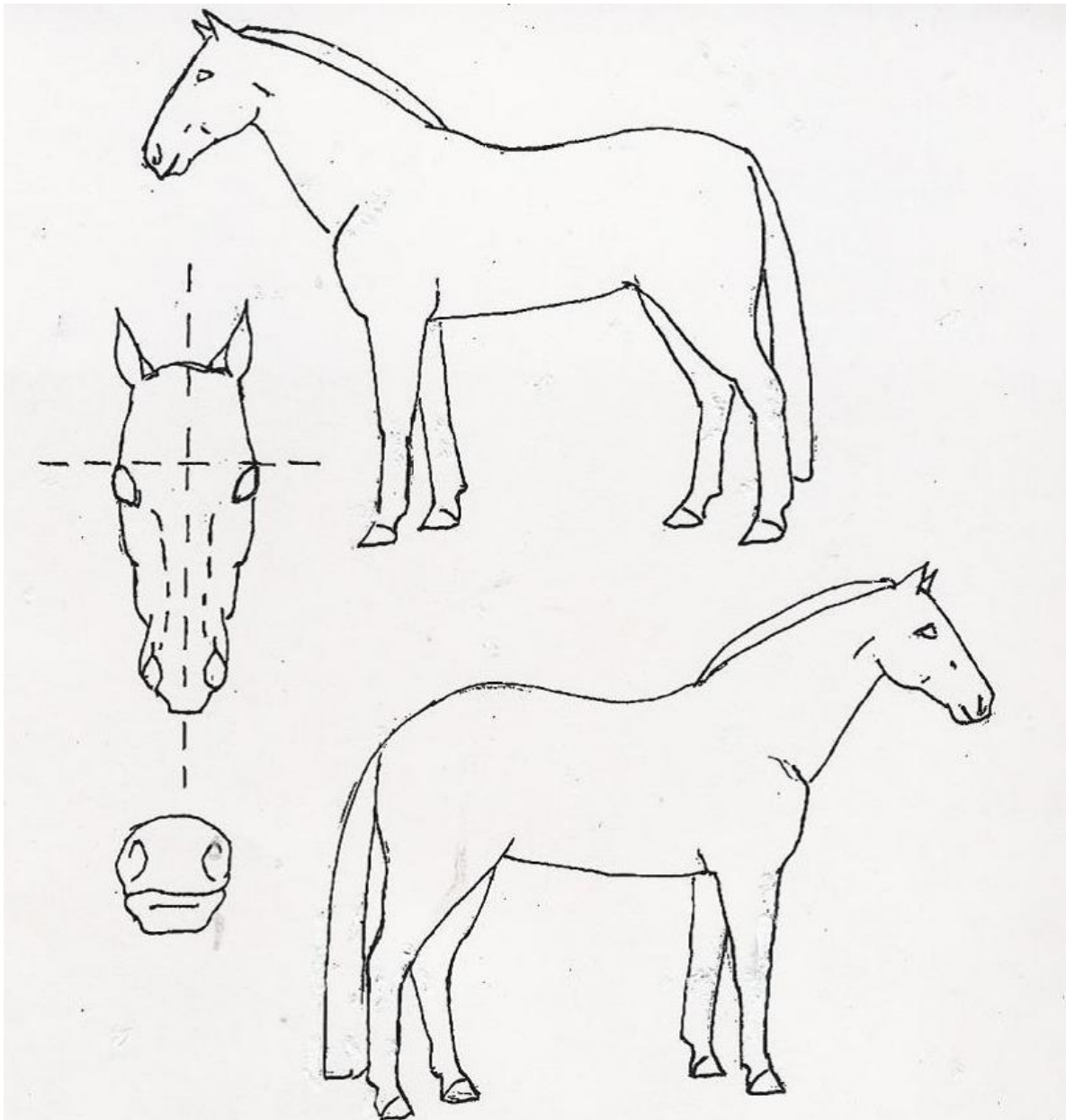
Sample Collection Process

1. Grasp 20-30 hairs as close as possible to the skin of the horse, wrap them around a finger and quickly pull the hair out in one motion – be aware that the horse may react by throwing its head toward you.
2. Do not cut, trim or otherwise handle the hairs, other than to twist them together and wrap a Sticky Label around the twist of hairs.
3. Place the sample in a small envelope, seal, attach to the Waler Registration Application where indicated below.
